Request to Amend the Desert Claim Wind Power Project Site Certification Agreement

On February 27, 2018 Desert Claim Wind Power LLC (Certificate Holder) requested the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (EFSEC) approve an amendment to the Desert Claim Wind Power Project Site Certification Agreement (SCA). If approved, the amendment would reduce the size of the Project from ninety five (95) turbines to thirty one (31) turbines with a capacity of no more than one hundred (100) megawatts. The Project would continue to be located in unincorporated Kittitas County, approximately eight (8) miles northwest of the city of Ellensburg.

Open House – 6:00 – 6:30 PM: The Certificate Holder and EFSEC staff will be available to answer questions about the Project and the EFSEC review process.

Public Hearing Session – 6:30 – 8:30 PM, or last speaker, whichever comes first. As required by WAC 463-66-030 EFSEC will hold a public hearing session. During this time the Certificate Holder will make a presentation on the proposed Project changes and EFSEC staff will describe the SCA amendment process. The public may also provide public comment during this time.
