Members of the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (EFSEC) will tour the Desert Claim Wind Power Project (Project) on Tuesday June 26, 2018. The tour will leave the Kittitas Valley Event Center at 12:00 PM promptly and proceed to the Project. The site visit is open to the public to the extent not disruptive of its purpose, but members of the public must provide their own transportation.

Tour participants should avoid communications with Council members expressing a position or opinion on the merits of the Project, the proposed sites, or the proposed design of the facilities. Advocacy or discussion of project details beyond those necessary to understand what the Certificate Holder has proposed in their Site Certification Agreement Amendment request may be considered ex parte communication and is not allowed.

This notice is being provided as required by RCW 42.30.080 for special meetings under the Open Public Meetings Act. However, the Council will take no final action,¹ and the purpose will be limited to viewing the proposed site locations and hearing a description of where the applicant has proposed to locate facilities.

¹ "Action" means the transaction of the official business of a public agency by a governing body including but not limited to receipt of public testimony, deliberations, discussions, considerations, reviews, evaluations, and final actions. "Final action" means a collective positive or negative decision, or an actual vote by a majority of the members of a governing body when sitting as a body or entity, upon a motion, proposal, resolution, order, or ordinance. RCW 42.30.020(3).
