THIS MATTER Having come on regularly before the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council at its regular meeting of January 25, 1982 upon petition by Rodney M. Reinbold, attorney for Blue Sky Advocates, a non-profit corporation, for intervention in the proceedings relating to the application for site certification by the Washington Water Power Company, the Council having reviewed the petition of the Blue Sky Advocates, voted to deny reconsideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED By the Council that the petition to reconsider be denied and that the Blue Sky Advocates be denied status as an intervenor in the proceedings relating to the application for site certification of the Washington Water Power Company Creston Generating Station.

Pursuant to WAC 463-30-400, those seeking status of intervenor must file a "timely application." The Council by Order No. 611 established that May 22, 1981 was the last date to file a petition in proper form. The order further stated: "Petitions filed after May 22, 1981, will be considered only upon the showing of good cause." The Council determined that the petition to intervene by the Blue Sky Advocates was neither timely nor showed "good cause" and that the petition to reconsider was not persuasive.
