
THIS MATTER Having come on regularly before the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council at its meeting of July 12, 1982, the Council having received direction from Governor John Spellman, dated July 7, 1982, to reconsider limited issues, and further having considered the letter opinion of June 23, 1982, of Judge Pro-Tem Orris L. Hamilton of the Thurston County Superior Court in Blue Sky Advocates v. EFSEC, as well as the records and files relating to the application for site certification by the Washington Water Power Company, the following actions were taken.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED By the Council that the following actions be taken.


1. The contested case record be reopened to consider evidence respecting the possible impact of SO<sub>2</sub> and acid rain upon crop yields in Lincoln County;
2. The Administrative Law Judge, Patrick Biggs, appointed by Council Order #598, is directed to convene a prehearing conference at the earliest reasonable time;
3. Authority is delegated to the Council Executive Committee for the establishment of a specific commencement date for the supplemental hearings; and
4. The time for application processing provided by RCW 80.50.100 is extended to December 31, 1982.
