ORDER OF INTERVENTION OF CITIZENS FOR A SAFE ENVIRON-MENT (CASE) OF GRAYS HARBOR COUNTY, WASHINGTON

Pursuant to WAC 463-08-025(b), and based upon the petitioner's Amended Petition to Intervene in the Application Hearing Process by Citizens for a Safe Environment (CASE) of Grays Harbor County, the Washington State Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council finds the petitioner has shown certain pertinent interests which the Council discerns appropriate for intervention.

NOW THEREFORE, Pursuant to the provisions of WAC 463-08-025(b), it is hereby ordered by the Washington State Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council that the Citizens for a Safe Environment (CASE) of Grays Harbor County be granted the standing of an intervenor subject to the following conditions with participation limited to:

- Interests which CASE has alleged and shown to the satisfaction of the Council to be appropriate interests for its participation;
 - a) Protection of the health and safety of CASE members residing within three miles of the proposed power plants where such alleged hazard is site related.
 - b) Evacuation procedures within the Council's jurisdiction which are to be utilized in the event such action is required; and

- c) The effect upon those fish species which are relied upon by CASE members for their livelihood.
- 2. Pertinent interests which CASE may establish to the satisfaction of the Council to be appropriate interests for its participation pursuant to WAC 463-08-025(b).
- 3. Nothing in this Order shall be construed to abrogate the intervention procedure cited in WAC 463-08-030(a)(b)(c)(d).
