

Resolution No. 129

WHEREAS by letter of July 20, 1977, the Puget Sound Power and Light Company did request in accordance with Article V.C.1. and 8. of the Site Certification Agreement for the Skagit Nuclear Project that the Council approve modifications to the Environmental Monitoring Program, and

WHEREAS licensing delays have constrained on-site project activity, and

WHEREAS three years of baseline data have been accumulated, and


WHEREAS the detectability of significant environmental/ecological changes will be maintained,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a reduced scope of the ongoing baseline monitoring activity with regard to terrestrial and aquatic biology and water quality shall be deemed satisfactory until the issuance of a Limited Work Authorization or Construction Permit and that the reduction in scope of the baseline portion of the monitoring program as described in the attachment to Skagit Nuclear Power Project Progress Report No. 77-2 is herewith approved.


