

RESOLUTION NO. 3-73

A resolution of the Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council commending its first legal counsel, Assistant Attorney General Charles F. Murphy, for his services in behalf of the Council.

WHEREAS, From the creation of the Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council by the enactment of Chapter 45, Laws of 1970, 1st Extraordinary Session, on February 23, 1970, until assuming his duties as Senior Assistant Attorney General for Washington State University on February 1, 1973, Charles F. Murphy did effectively and faithfully serve as the Council's legal counsel; and



WHEREAS, His constant willingness to be of assistance in all of the Council's requirements was appreciated by the Council, its Chairman and staff;


