

RESOLUTION NO. 5-74

A Resolution of the Washington State Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council establishing the date of May 13, 1974, for an informational hearing regarding Application No. 74-1.

WHEREAS, The Puget Sound Power & Light Company on March 28, 1974, submitted an application to the Washington State Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council for the certification of a nuclear fueled thermal power plant site approximately five miles east of Sedro Woolley, Washington, in Skagit County, and


WHEREAS, RCW 80.50.090 requires that within sixty (60) days of the receipt of an application, a hearing be held at a location as close as practical to the proposed site at which time the Council will determine whether or not the proposed site is consistent, and in compliance, with county or regional land use plans and zoning ordinances; and

WHEREAS, The Rules of Practice of the Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council, WAC 463-08-035, provide a format and rules for the conduct of this initial hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council that the initial public hearing as provided for by RCW 80.50.090 and WAC 463-08-035 regarding the Puget Sound Power & Light Company's application for site certification (No. 74-1) of a nuclear power plant in Skagit County referred to as


the Skagit Nuclear Power Project shall be held at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, May 13, 1974, in Skagit County, and that notice of said hearing shall be given as provided by law.
