NOTICE OF INTENT TO HOLD ORAL
ARGUMENTS AND A PREHEARING
CONFERENCE:

Tuesday November 13, 2007
Starting at 10:00 a.m.

The Washington State Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (EFSEC) will hear oral arguments and conduct a prehearing conference, concerning the Pacific Mountain Energy Center starting at 10:00 a.m., November 13, 2007, at the Town Square, Building 4, Conference Room 301, 905 Plum Street SE, Olympia, Washington 98501.

AGENDA

10:00 AM – 11:30 AM: Oral Argument: The Council previously scheduled oral argument for Tuesday, November 13, beginning at 10:00 AM., on questions it presented to parties on the greenhouse gas reduction plan. The Prehearing Conference Order No. 832 noted that argument will be held unless cancelled.

On the issues raised in the questions, 30 minutes are allocated to the applicant, and 30 minutes to be divided among other parties as they agree. Each side may divide its time between its initial presentation and a response to opposing arguments. Parties should assume that Council members have read the parties' briefs. Time for any questions from the Council and for responses to such questions, will *not* be added on a minute-for-minute basis, but the schedule allows for additional time for explication that the Council believes necessary.

1:30 PM – 2:00 PM: Prehearing Conference: Parties are asked to have an agreed issues list available to the Council for discussion at the prehearing conference, and to distribute the list electronically to the Council and the presiding administrative law judge no later than **Friday, November 9, 2007**. In addition, parties are asked to propose an agreed suggested schedule for prosecuting the remainder of the proceeding, beginning either with entry of a Council order directing the matter to proceed, or with expiration of a stay for perfection of the greenhouse gas reduction plan. In the absence of an agreed schedule, parties should discuss differences, understand both the nature of differences and opponents' reasons for preferred dates, and be prepared to discuss alternatives.
