

**WASHINGTON STATE

PUBLIC NOTICE AND PUBLIC HEARING**

**For the
TENTATIVE DETERMINATION TO ISSUE THE
DRAFT NPDES INDUSTRIAL STORMWATER PERMIT FOR VANCOUVER ENERGY**

In accordance with Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 80.50 and RCW 90.48, and Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 463-76-005 and WAC 463-76-010 **NOTICE** is hereby given that the Washington State Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (EFSEC) has made a tentative determination to issue for public comment the draft National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Industrial Stormwater Permit for Vancouver Energy (Applicant), 5501 NW Old Lower River Road, Vancouver, Washington, 98660. Permit compliance will be governed by applicable provisions of RCW 80.50, RCW 90.48, WAC 173-201A, WAC 463-76, and WAC 463-70.

The Applicant is proposing to construct an Energy Distribution Terminal Facility to receive crude oil by rail car, to store it onsite and load it onto marine vessels, primarily for delivery to refineries located on the West Coast of North America. The NPDES Industrial Stormwater Permit provides coverage for industrial operational activities proposed by the Applicant. Also included in the tentative determination is a Fact Sheet, which summarizes the Permit conditions.

The receiving water for this project is the Columbia River.
