Council Order No. 815
Order on Application for Transfer of Site Certification Agreement, and Approval of Other Assurances Pursuant to Article VIII.D.3 of the Site Certification Agreement

All Interested Persons take note:

On August 30, 2005, pursuant to Chapter 80.50 of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW), and section 463-66-100 of the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (EFSEC or Council) approved Council Order No. 815, Order on Application for Transfer of Site Certification Agreement, and Approval of Other Assurances Pursuant to Article VIII.D.3 of the Site Certification Agreement, thereby authorizing the transfer of the Site Certification Agreement (SCA) for the Wild Horse Wind Power Project, from Wind Ridge Power Partners LLC to Puget Sound Energy.

This Council decision is subject only to judicial review pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 34.05 RCW (Administrative Procedure Act). In accordance with RCW 34.05.514(1), petitions for review of this decision may be filed in Thurston County, the county of the petitioner's residence or principal place of business, or in any county where the property owned by the petitioner and affected by the contested decision is located. Pursuant to the requirements of RCW 34.05.542(2), petitions for review of the Council's decision in this matter are not timely unless filed with the court and served on EFSEC, the Office of the Attorney General, and all other parties of record within 30 days of the Council's action.
