Revision of the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council's Startup, Shutdown, and
Malfunction Provisions in WAC 173-400-040(2), adopted by reference in WAC
463-78-005(2)(b)

Dear Administrator Sixkiller:

As the Governor's designee for the Washington State Implementation Plan, I am submitting a partial withdrawal of the following portion of the Washington State Implementation Plan Revision for the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council's Startup, Shutdown, and Malfunction provisions adopted by reference in Chapter 463-78 WAC (the "EFSEC 2023 SSM SIP Revision"), which Ecology submitted to EPA on June 15, 2023, in response to the 2015 SIP Call:

- Ecology hereby withdraws from the EFSEC 2023 SSM SIP Revision the portion that adopts by reference **WAC 173-400-040(2)**, including the rows of Table 1 at pages 20-21 that address changes to General Standards for Maximum Emissions.
- All other portions of the EFSEC 2023 SSM SIP Revision remain unchanged.

A copy of the partial withdrawal request letter that the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council submitted to Ecology is attached for reference. Ecology is submitting this partial withdrawal notice online through the EPA's State Planning Electronic Collaboration System (SPeCS) for SIPs. Additionally, we will publish a copy of the partial withdrawal on Ecology's website.
