RESOLUTION NO. 1-71

A Resolution of the Washington State Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council establishing the date of March 8, 1971, for an informational hearing regarding Site Application No. TPPSEC No. 71-1.

WHEREAS, The Washington Public Power Supply System on January 28, 1971, submitted an application to the Washington State Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council for the certification of a nuclear fueled thermal power plant on the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission Reservation near Richland, Washington; and

WHEREAS, R.C.W. 80.50.090 requires that within sixty days of the receipt of an application a hearing be held at a location as close as practical to the proposed site at which time the Council will determine whether or not the proposed site is consistent, and in compliance, with county or regional land use plans and zoning ordinances, and

WHEREAS, The Rules of Practice of the Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council, W.A.C. 463-08-035, provide a format and rules for the conduct of this initial hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council that the initial public hearing as provided for by R.C.W. 80.50.090 and W.A.C. 463-08-035 regarding the Washington Public Power Supply System application for site certification (TPPSEC No. 71-1) of a nuclear power plant on the Atomic Energy Commission Hanford Reservation, referred to as Hanford No. 2, shall be held at 1:30 P.M. on Monday, March 8, 1971, in the Council Chambers,

City Hall, Richland, Washington, and that notice of said hearing shall be given as provided by law.
