They are enlisting the Core of Engineers to clear the way for their oil to be shipped out to foreign markets in your state.

They've gotten the US House to pass a bill they passed a bill that will limit EPA oversight of their projects and will block our government from making sure that oil and gas companies stick to the rules that were set up to try to avoid chemical spills and water contamination. See:
