Pursuant to Chapter 246-247-080(6) of the Washington Administrative Code (WAC), Energy Northwest has submitted a report of closure for the activity associated with the storm drain pond decommissioning. We concur that the emission unit for the storm drain pond decommissiong is no longer a source of radioactive air emissions and should be closed. This letter serves as a recommendation that EFSEC order No. 875 (which issued the radioactive air emissions license for the decommissioning of the storm drain pond) be closed.
