A.2. No person or entity has filed a petition to intervene.

B. Jurisdiction

The Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this proceeding and the parties to it under the regulatory authority established in Chapter 80.50 RCW. *See* RCW 80.50.040(7), RCW 80.50.060(1)(b)(ii), and WAC 463-30-080.

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C. Subject Properties

C.1. The real property that is the subject of the Wautoma Solar Energy Project Application for Site Certification – Volume I ("Application") consists of the thirty-five (35) parcels (the "Subject Properties"). *See* Application, pgs. 2-3.

9 10 C.2 The Subject Properties collectively total five thousand eight hundred fifty-two (5,852) acres. *Id.*, p. 5.

11 C.3 The Subject Properties are all located within Benton County's Growth Management Act Agriculture District ("GMAAD"). *Id.*

D. Application

D.1 The Wautoma Solar Energy Project ("Project") is proposed for
 development by Innergex Renewable Development USA, LLC ("Applicant"). See
 Application, generally.

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D.2 The Project is proposed for development in Benton County. *Id.*, p.

D.3 The Project is proposed primarily on land leased from privately
owned by Robert and Marilyn Ford; Wautoma Energy LLC; Robert Ranch 5+1 LLC; Et
Al Michael V Robert; High Valley Land LLC; Jean Emile Robert; and Robin Robert in
Benton Co, WA. *Id.*, pgs. 2-3.

D.4 The Application states the proposed Project shall be to "construct and operate the Wautoma Solar Energy Project..." consisting of a 470-megawatt solar photovoltaic generation facility coupled with a 4-hour, 470-MW battery energy storage system, as well as related interconnection and ancillary support infrastructure. *Id.* p. 4.

D.5 The amount of land constituting the Project Area is approximately
 4,573 acres of the total Subject Properties. *Id.* p. 5.

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STIPULATION OF FACTS - 2



Within the Project Area a smaller area of approximately 2,978 1 D.6 acres, will be unavailable for agricultural use during the operational period of the project.¹ 2 D.7 In general, the Project Area is on relatively flat terrain with slopes 3 of less than 3%. Id. p. 6. 4 D.8 There are 649,153 acres of GMAAD-zoned land in Benton County. 5 D.9 The total area of the Subject Property (5,852 acres) makes up .09% percent (nine-tenths of one percent) of the total GMADD zoned land in Benton County 6 (649,153 acres) and the area that would be unavailable for agricultural use (2,978 acres) 7 during the life of the Project is slightly less than one half of one percent (0.045%), slightly less than one-half of one percent of the total GMAAD zoned land in Benton County. 8 Applicant Innergex engaged with Benton County Community D.10 9 Development Department and Planning Division via email in July 2021 to introduce the Wautoma Solar Project and discuss the local permitting process. 10 In the spring of 2022, Innergex presented to the Benton County 11 D.11 BOCC the Wautoma Solar Project. 12 D.12 The Application was submitted by Innergex to Washington's 13 Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (EFSEC or Council) for review on June 9, 2022. See Application. 14 The Application requests the Council recommend to the governor a D.13 15 Site Certification that reflects pre-emption of the County's planning and zoning provisions, with conditions related to the County's applicable planning and zoning 16 provisions. *Id*. 17 **E. Procedural History** 18 E.1 The Council held a public informational meeting and land use 19 consistency hearing at the Columbia Basin College's Gjerde Center Building in Pasco, Benton County on August 8, 2022. 20 E.2 The Council, on November 15, 2022, issued an Order Finding 21 Project Inconsistent with Land Use Regulations ("Order"). See Order filed herein. 22 23 24 ¹ Memorandum Re: Environmental Review and Staff Recommendation for State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) Review and SEPA Determination for Wautoma Solar, 25 EFSEC May 15, 2024.  E.3 The Order determined the land use consistency matter should be set for consideration by Council concurrent with the general adjudication required by RCW 80.50.090(4) in order to consider whether to recommend preemption of Benton County's zoning regulations. *Id*.

E.4 The Order determined that if the environmental impacts of the
Project are determined to be non-significant (State Environmental Policy Act [SEPA]
Determination of Non Significance [DNS]) or mitigated to a non-significant level (a
SEPA Mitigated Determination of Non Significance [MDNS]), the Council may limit the
topic of the general adjudicative proceeding to whether any applicable local land use plans
or zoning ordinances with which the proposed site is determined to be inconsistent should
be preempted.

8 E.5 EFSEC issued, for public comment between May 20 and June 3,
 9 2024, a MDNS inclusive of Project conditions on topics including, but not limited to,
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E.6 EFSEC received 9 written comments regarding the MDNS.

12E.7Benton County did not submit any written comments regarding the
MDNS.

E.8 Table A.5. of the Application contains a summary of mitigation measures that the Applicant proposed and agrees to have included. *See* Application, pgs. 27-37

E.9 EFSEC issued a Revised MDNS that retained all conditions on
Land Use proposed in the ASC and included additional conditions.

E.10 Applicant agrees to the imposition of all MDNS conditions in a site certification agreement.

19E.11Appendix D of the Application is the Applicant's analysis of LandUse Consistency.

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F. Land Use and Zoning Restrictions

F.1 Benton County conducts land use planning and zoning under the Growth Management Act, Chapter 36.70A RCW.
