Hello Joan,

Thank you for the notice provided. Construction site operators are required to be covered by a Construction Stormwater General Permit if they are engaged in clearing, grading, and excavating activities that disturb one or more acres and discharge stormwater to surface waters of the state. Smaller sites may also require coverage if they are part of a larger common plan of development that will ultimately disturb one acre or more. Permit can also be required if an inspector has deemed the project to be a potential significant contributor such as site or ground water contaminations.

If there is a need for the Construction Stormwater general permit the application process is online. Please see the link below that provides instructions and additional information.

You must apply for a permit at least 60 days before discharging stormwater from your construction site. We try to issue coverage 45 days after receiving a complete application (a minimum of 30 days is required for the public comment period).
